A grade of A or A- should have been received for any course you wish to facilitate. A grade of B- or better should have been received for any course you wish to assist. Facilitators and Assistants will attend regular meetings throughout the semester with Mr. Garcia. Required Training will occur before school starts, some time in August. If you have not attended the 4.0 presentation, you will need to attend. We are looking for leaders who will support the Guaranteed 4.0 Learning System, and model those techniques to workshop students. Facilitators will have to hold weekly office hours two hours per week. If you cannot adhere to all of this please do not apply.
